Youth Exchange project within Erasmus + KA1





About the project

The development of individual national societies as well as European one is largely related to the quality of individual media types. We, together with our partners, are aware of these facts and therefore we have the will to continually improve and look for a new creative ways of professional balanced storytelling as well as to come up with new ideas for projects that will help to increase positive society awareness. - acquire a new knowledge of the topics on which it is important to open public dialogue and how they should be presented to the public
- jointly evaluate appropriate writing styles as well as other media tools on the basis of mutual exchange of experiences from their countries
- be more aware of different project grant schemes, which will enable them to participate in the new interesting projects in the future

- expand the fundraising horizons that are very important for the running of each nonprofit organization
- improve in the field of PR and marketing, which are an important part of the success of every organization, especially working in the media sector

Practical information for participants

Activity dates: 18-25.9.2017 (18th - arrival day; 25th – departure day)

<u>Venue</u>: SLOVAKIA, Modra. Modra also called the capital of wine has always benefited from its favorable location, on one side surrounded by the Little Carpathians and on the other by the descending Danubian Hills. Specific natural and climatic conditions allow forest vegetation to flourish in Modra's mountainous areas while lower elevations are covered with fertile vineyards. The city lies in the southwestern corner of Slovakia, approximately 25 kilometers distance from Bratislava, the capital.

<u>Accomodation:</u> Penzión Club M.K.M. situated in the historical center of Modra. It's really cozy and comfortable pension that offers a free using of swimming pool and sauna (http://www.clubmkm.sk/)

Number of participants per country: 4 participants (18-30) + 1 leader (unlimited age).

<u>Travel arrangements:</u> you are expected to communicate with us about your travel arrangements and forward flight/train/bus booking confirmations/invoices and itineraries to us.

Financial information

Accommodation and food are fully covered by Erasmus+ Program and is taken care of by the European Dialogue.

Participants will receive reimbursement of their *travel costs* up to the amount indicated below according to their country of residence (allocated by Erasmus+ grant):

Slovakia – 80 EUR Germany – 170 EUR Sweden – 170 EUR Portugal – 270 EUR Montenegro – 170 EUR Austria – 80 EUR

Tickets for travel from Vienna airport to Bratislava (or directly to Modra) and back are included in these amounts; separated tickets from Bratislava to Modra and back are not included in these amounts and will be reimbursed 100% or paid directly by organisers.

Although travel costs will be reimbursed, participants will be expected to make their own travel arrangements as soon as possible after being selected. Participants will be also expected to take the cheapest route from their place of residence to Bratislava and use following means of the transportation:

- Train: 2nd class ticket (normal as well as high-speed trains),
- Flight: return economy-class air ticket or a cheaper ticket,
- Bus,
- Car

What shall participants bring with them?

Materials about their organisations: During the youth exchange all the participants will get an opportunity to present their sending organisations. We encourage you to bring as much materials as possible. The preparation of a short PowerPoint presentation about the organization is more than welcome.

Intercultural evening: Participants shall bring something typical from their place: food, drinks, traditional clothes, music and whatever they consider interesting to show. You can prepare some videos, quiz, or PowerPoint presenting your country. It would great to show us some kind of interesting media though (their work, some video or whatever you find interesting about them; it could be whatever what is for example extraordinary or has some extra value for you)

Preparation of the activity: Each national group is expected to prepare selected topic and come up some interactive activities (it can include a presentation about the topic and then some kind of interactive workshop or whatever you consider proper) We ask all the participants to cooperate with your group leader who are in charge of it and to help them with some ideas for your topic.

Comfortable clothes: Participants shall make sure to bring comfortable clothes. You never know what weather will be in Slovakia in September, in addiction we will be leaving close to the forest so we can make some of the activities outside. Don't forget your swim wear, an umbrella, some kind of elegant clothes since we plan to visit a few places where you should not take any sportswear (for example jeans and some kind of shirt or dress is enough)

Personal insurance: All the participants are expected to provide themselves adequate medical and travel insurance which we strongly recommend. Unfortunately it cannot be reimbursed.

Proof of travel expenses: Participants are asked to send flight/train/bus booking confirmation/invoice to their sending organisation or directly to organisers before the event. They should make sure to keep all receipts, tickets and boarding passes, and send them together with the reimbursement form (will be sent to them in advance) to organisers via priority mail within one month after the event. If they have all required documents in electronic form (they bought e-tickets or checked-in for flight online), they will be allowed to submit all documents on the spot.

How to reach Modra?


Depending on your flights you are expected to buy a bus/train tickets in order to get to Modra. You can find all the useful information about how to do it below.

HOW TO REACH BRATISLAVA FROM VIENNA AIRPORT - SCHWECHAT

The easiest way is to take direct bus from Vienna airport to Bratislava – Bus station. The red bus operated by **SLOVAK LINES** will take you to Bratislava – Bus station just in 1 hour, and the cost of tickets it's about 9€, for both ways.





HOW TO REACH MODRA FROM BRATISLAVA – Bus Station






HOW TO REACH BRATISLAVA – FROM BUDAPEST AIRPORT

BY TRAIN FROM MAIN RAILWAY STATION IN BUDAPEST TO THE AIRPORT

If you want to get from the railway station to the airport, you are proceeding from point 4 to point 1.

- 1. Buy two single journey tickets (HU-vonaljegy). Please ask at the airport information where you can buy the tickets for a public transport. There should be some sellers and also the ticket machine, where you can buy the ticket just in cash. One ticket costs 350 HUF (≤ 1.12)
- 2. When you get out the airport, you have to find the bus platform where **the blue bus 200E** is going from (usually there are the most people). Mark the first ticket and **the bus 200 E** will take you to the terminus metro station named **Kőbánya-Kispest.** It takes about 20 minutes.
- 3. When you enter the metro, mark the second ticket and go to **the Blue Line M3** in the direction of "Újpest Központ" to "Kálvin tér".
- 4. You should follow the signs in the metro and cross the **Green Line M4 in the "Kelenföldi pályaudvar"** direction where you take you to the final stop **"Kelenföldi pályaudvar"**, which is the Central railway station.




FROM MAIN RAILWAY STATION IN BUDAPEST (Budapest Keleti pályaudvar) TO BRATISLAVA, MAIN RAILWAY STATION

The easiest way is to take train from <u>Budapest Keleti pályaudvar</u> to Bratislava – Main Railway Station. The journey lasts about 2 hour and 45 minutes.

You can buy ticket in advance.



When you get out of the train, you have to go out of the station - you will easily find the platform (number 2) of the public transport (red bus). At firt you have to buy ticket in yellow ticket machine, only in cash (it costs about 0,70€, time interval of ticket 15 minutes).

Then you can get in bus nr. 210 – NOVE SND – from Hlavna stanica to Autobusova stanica.



HOW TO REACH MODRA FROM BRATISLAVA – Bus Station





<u>HOW TO REACH BRATISLAVA – FROM BUDAPEST – AIRPORT</u> - Budapest Népliget (Bus Station)

If you want to get from the bus station to the airport, you are proceeding from point 4 to point 1

- 4. You are already at the Main bus station "Budapest Népliget". Just find the platform where your bus to Bratislava goes from
